About GCOEARA

The Government of Maharashtra has established Government College of Engineering and Research, Avasari (Khurd), in the year 2009 with an aim to spread engineering education in the rural parts of Maharashtra State in order to produce technically strong expertise in the engineering field. The institute is Approved by All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE, New Delhi) and affiliated to the renowned "Savitribai Phule Pune University", Pune. The institute imparts technical education in six disciplines, viz. Automobile Engineering, Mechanical Engineering, Computer Engineering, Civil Engineering, Instrumentation and Control Engineering, and Electronics & Telecommunication Engineering.

Presently students are graduating in large number from various colleges all over India. Because of industrial recession the job creation capacity is very low, by which many graduates are unemployed. Similarly there are certain limitations in the government sector to provide job opportunities. Hence the alternative available, is to make the students self employable.

As entrepreneurs are the backbone of the developing nation we must inculcate the entrepreneurship qualities and make them aware about the opportunities and knowledge of the government schemes available and facilities amongst the graduating students. This may reduce the unemployability problem and make them keen on putting their energies and ideas to make productive use by adopting entrepreneurship as a career.

Keeping this view "GCOEARA" has established the Entrepreneurship Development and Start Up Centre (EDSUC) in the year 2018. EDSUC is a non-profit student's organization dedicated for promoting and building the spirit of entrepreneurship among students coming throughout Maharashtra.

Proposed Functions under the MOU:

1. To organize Entrepreneurship Awareness Camps, Entrepreneurship Development Programmes, Technical Entrepreneurship Development Programmes and Faculty Development Programmes in the institution for the benefit of students.
2. To develop and introduce curriculum on Entrepreneurship Development at various levels including degree/diploma courses of the parent institution and other institutes in the region.
3. To conduct research work and survey for identifying entrepreneurial opportunities



4. To guide and assist prospective entrepreneurs on various aspects such as preparing project reports, obtaining project approvals, loans and facilities from agencies of support system, information on technologies, etc.
5. To organize guest lectures, TV and Radio talks, Seminars, etc. for promotion and growth of entrepreneurship.
6. To arrange visits to industries for prospective entrepreneurs.
7. To extend necessary guidance and escort services to the trainees in obtaining approval and execution of their projects.

9. To provide testing, calibration, quality assurance, design, tool room, pilot plant and other facilities for entrepreneurs besides expertise in intellectual property rights, patents search, etc.

11. To conduct skill development training programmes leading to self/wage employment

2. MCED will conduct various Entrepreneurship Development based training programme in GCOEARA for college students and faculties.
3. MCED will support to develop Entrepreneurship library for potential users.
4. MCED will contribute in image building of GCOEARA.
5. MCED will provide support for forward and backward linkages.
6. MCED will create common platform for industries and students.
7. MCED shall help and support students of GCOEARA for Internship, In-Plant training and Project.
8. MCED will Encourage GCOEARA student in technology start-up on the campus.
9. MCED will support for conducting National and International conferences in the field of entrepreneurship.

Role of GCOEARA:

1. Institute will provide Office space for setting up of ED Cell.
2. Institute will help in promoting MCED programmes among the college students.
3. Institute will make available training hall as and when required and Notice Boards for promoting activities of MCED.
4. GCOEARA would jointly conduct Seminars and Conferences to update the knowledge of staff, faculty members and students of the region.



5. GCOEARA will jointly arrange for lectures, expert talks, workshops, and Programmes periodically to inculcate the spirit of entrepreneurship amongst the students.
6. GCOEARA would arrange discussion sessions for the staff and students, which will help GCOEARA to design various certificate and diploma courses for the requirement of MCED.
7. GCOEARA will support the activities of MCED by technological and engineering human resources.
8. GCOEARA will support and shall jointly conduct social and academic research in areas of mutual interest.


Validity and Arbitrations:
